

# Master's Programs: Application

## Online Application

Applications can be submitted online at

You can only apply for one master's program at a time.

## Application Deadlines

The application deadlines for the **1st semester are listed** in the table. The application portal opens at least 6 weeks before the application deadline. The table also indicates whether the master's program can be started in the winter or summer semester.

**Advanced students** can usually apply for both the winter and summer semester. The deadline for the winter semester is identical to the deadline for first-year students and the deadline for the summer semester is 15.1. Advanced students always have to prove academic achievements in a matching master's program amounting to at least 10 CP.

## R = Restricted Approval

For Master's degree programs with restricted admission the number of study places is limited. The criteria for the allocation of study places are explained in the respective admission regulations.

## Prerequisites

- Minimum CP: this is the number of CPs from the bachelor's degree that must be proven at the time of application. The bachelor's degree must be verified two weeks after the start of the semester.
- Language requirement: Proof can usually be provided up to two weeks after the start of the course. Language certificates in brackets must be submitted by the application deadline.
- Grades: Minimum grade in the bachelor's degree at the time of application.
- Test T: an entrance or aptitude test is required.

## Double Degree DD

In master's degree programs with a double degree, students usually acquire two international degrees. DD students must complete part of the curriculum at a foreign university.
