Upon completion, the master thesis is defended in a final colloquium. The companion seminar explores mechanisms of research and prepares students for conducting their own large-scale investigations. It assists students in the formulation of their own research questions, putting a strong emphasis on the development of an appropriate theoretical foundation in light of methodological issues associated with conducting scientific investigations.

		In addition, students practice critical reflection and evaluation of other research projects developed in the course of the module.
