

Media registration regulations

By submitting your application for complimentary media registration for the 15th ICRS 2022, you agree you will adhere the embargo policy, virtual environment policy, and interview policy of 15th ICRS 2022 in Bremen.

Embargo Policy

Reporting of scientific data and results presented at the meeting is strictly prohibited until the start of each presentation. Coverage includes all media channels: Print, electronic such as social media, blogs and posts, video and audio.

If a separate restriction is noted for a particular presentation, reporting is strictly prohibited until the date and time specified.

Content that is pre-published online in advance of print publication remains subject to the 15th ICRS 2022 embargo policy unless the authors provide written consent to nullify the embargo.

Meeting Media Guidelines

All scientific presentations are open to the media.

If participating in any chats and discussions associated to the meeting in any way, registered members of the media must indicate that they are a member of the press. *Example: Heinz Krimmer, daily newspaper XY, question: Do strict protected areas for coral reefs also help against the threats of climate change?*

Photography, video and/or audio taping of the sessions, presentations, or posters is strictly prohibited.

Interview Policies

All interviews are coordinated through the 15th ICRS 2022 media office:

We ask that interview requests be made a few days in advance if possible so that there is enough time to schedule an appointment.

Attendee Communications

Anyone attending the 15th ICRS 2022 should be respectful of the research findings and data presented by recognizing that the information is not available to the public yet and thus cannot be shared. This pertains to all attendees, including registered participants and the media. Members of the press must speak to any researcher or speaker if developing a story to be published about their findings.

Promotion of products, organizations, or services, and distribution of study results without permission are prohibited.
