| <b>1j</b> | learning contents                            | Plants play key role in sustaining life on earth as source of food, shelter and energy. Polyploidization, an increase in genome copies, has been a major driving force for the increase in performance of crop plants and continues to be important breeding goal. We recently discovered that polyspermy, the fusion of an egg with two sperm, is route towards polyploidization. However, polyspermy barriers are in place making this a rare event. To tackle the bottleneck of polyspermy block, the students will target potential polyspermy regulating molecular factors making use of CRISPR/Cas9 based gene editing tool. |
