

# UBremen Summer Campus 2024 in Business Studies and Economics

## Program

The **Summer School Business Studies and Economics** includes courses on undergraduate level. We suggest all students choose two courses. Every course has 6 ECTS credits. Students study together with Bremen and international students as the courses take place during the regular semester.

The **Language and Cultural Training** practices the intercultural awareness through training and group tasks in English and German. Students learn German in online lessons during the semester and apply their new language skills in the final presentations. The Language and Cultural Training has 6 ECTS credits.

In cooperation with firms from the region we offer the **PRAXIS Summer Camp**, a project-based course in which the students work on real life problems in international student teams. Depending on the firms' structures and equipment, the students are offered a working room in the firms' buildings or work self-organized on campus. There is a contact person from the firm for every team and a lecturer from university supervises the project work. Final presentations take place in the firms and at university. The PRAXIS Summer Camp has 6 ECTS credits. Certificates are provided.

The workload of the program is fulltime and attendance is expected in all courses.

## Housing

The Faculty offers assistance in finding an apartment but can no longer provide accommodation on campus. Students are free to find their own apartment in Bremen. The University of Bremen is located in the Northeast of Bremen. A list of districts that are advisable can be provided, if needed. With the public transportation it is really easy to get to the campus

from everywhere in or around the City of Bremen.
