We sincerely invite you to join us for the

German- Ukrainian-Polish Workshop "New wave of migration in reaction to the full-scale Russian invasion in Ukraine. Social and economic consequences for Ukraine and EU countries" (July, 17-18, 2023),

which is organized by the Chair of Economics of Innovation and Structural Change, Faculty of Business Studies and Economics, University of Bremen, Germany. The event will take place in a hybrid format with participation either in person in Bremen or via video conference.

The workshop will consist of seven thematic sections:

- 1. Political and social instability in Ukraine as a determining factor of new migration challenges;
- 2. The biggest migration crisis in Europe since World War II: flows of Ukrainian refugees over the world and internal migration in Ukraine;
- 3. Assistance for Ukrainian citizens in host countries and their social adaptation;
- 4. Internal migration flows, problems of internally displaced persons' adaptation, the search for missing Ukrainians and the issue of their release from Russian captivity;
- 5. Challenges for Ukrainian national economy under war conditions: difficulties, risks and possible solution;
- 6. Challenges and new possibilities for host countries' national economies;
- 7. Post-war Ukrainian economy recovery: key directions, perspectives, transformations of Ukrainian society in the context of future EU membership.
