Structural change in times of increasing openness

Claudius Gräßner is a research associate at the Institute of Socio-Economics of the University of Duisburg-Essen and the Institute of Comprehensive Analysis of the Economy (ICAE) of the Johannes Kepler University Linz (Austria).

In his presentation he will analyze the dynamics of structural polarization and macroeconomic divergence in the context of European integration, where the latter is primarily understood as an increase in economic and financial openness. He will demonstrate that different country groups have responded in a distinct way to the openness shock imposed by European integration and argue that the latter should be seen as an evolutionary process that has given rise to different path-dependent developmental trajectories.
