

Arrival by train:

When leaving the central station take the South exit for Stadmitte (city center). Taxies and trams leave directly from the station forecourt. The taxi fare will be about 10 Euro. The tram is cheaper: take the number 6 tram in the direction "Universität". You can alight at stop "Klagenfurter Straße" and walk for 8 minutes.

Arrival by car:

When approaching Bremen by road on the A1, change to the A27 in the direction of Bremen-Bremerhaven. Exist the A27 at junction Universität / Horn-Lehe and follow the signs for Zentrum / Universität.

Arrival by plane:

The taxi fare from the airport to the university will cost you about 20 Euro. Tram line number 6 will take you directly to the University. You can alight at the terminus "Klagenfurter Straße" and walk for 8 minutes
