


Dear Students,

The coronavirus pandemic is changing a lot, even here on the university campus. The university is required to support the health authorities if contact chains have to be reconstructed for possible COVID-19 infections.

Unfortunately, this is not possible “just like that.” You notice it most clearly when you want to get into the university buildings. We would like to briefly describe the measures and what they mean for you.

When am I allowed to enter a university building to attend my course?


Very important: you have to be registered for the respective in-person course. You can find out whether you are registered or not via the learning platform Stud.IP. On the home page, scroll all the way down to the bottom, where you will find the “My in-person appointments” area. It looks like this:

And if you click on “My in-person appointments,” you will be shown the in-person appointments for which you are registered.

You will find your personal QR code on the left next to the attendance dates. This is your “ticket” to the in-person courses and the respective university buildings.



Please print out the QR code or save a screenshot on your smartphone. If you logged into Stud. IP on your phone, your individual QR code will also appear there.

How do I get into the building?

In most buildings, you will find a small reader/terminal at the entrance, in front of which you hold the QR code. If the terminal shows a green signal and beeps briefly, you are allowed to enter the building; if a red signal appears and beeps long, you cannot enter.



What do I do if there is a red signal?

First of all, clarify whether you are standing at the right building and whether your course is actually taking place in that building. If everything is in order here, please contact the security guards at the entrances. Please present your student ID or QR code to the security staff. You will then be let in by way of exception.

The university is working to eliminate any technical errors that may occur. We therefore assume that by the end of this week, all errors will have been eliminated. You can only enter the building if the terminal actually lights up green.

How does all this work if there is no terminal in front of the building?

First of all, there are hardly any buildings left without a terminal. In such cases, please contact the security staff. They will have a list with your name on it if you are allowed to enter a certain building on a certain day to participate in an in-person course.

What else is important for in-person teaching?

Please check the University of Bremen's coronavirus update regularly. There you will also find information to help you and your fellow students get through the semester safely. And find out whether there are any changes to the in-person/online teaching of your courses via Stud.IP.

What if I have booked a learning location?

So far, you will receive an e-mail with your booking confirmation. This e-mail is then also the "ticket" to get into the building. Show the e-mail to the security guards and you can get in without any problems. We are also updating this procedure so that you can enter the building with your personal QR code in future.
