December 1 – 5, 2025



The future of decision-making requires an **interdisciplinary approach** that integrates diverse perspectives to address complex global challenges.

Participants will critically reflect on the challenges and practical implications of the decisions that will shape the future – with special emphasis on **digital governance**, **smart cities**, and the **ethical dimensions of technology and governance**.

This **five-day interactive event** engages students, academics from diverse fields (political science, economics, law, artificial intelligence (AI) research, and philosophy), policymakers, as well as industry and administrative professionals in **collaborative dialogue and practical problem-solving**.

The **3 ECTS-course** is designed for graduate and advanced undergraduate students studying Political Science, Economics, Law, Philosophy, Professional Public Decision-Making, and related fields.
