The English for University Staff working group consists of administrators and instructors who organize and/or teach English courses for the administrative, technical or academic staff (or any combination of these) through their language centers or personnel departments. The working group's aim is to provide the opportunity for both the administrators and instructors of these courses to exchange ideas on best practice, course content and course organization.

Managing the expectations of course participants and universities will be one of the key points of the meeting. The participants' need for English for Specific Purposes will be discussed as well as questions around qualifications in the language and language competence in key areas of work. Additionally, we will cover formats of instruction that go beyond those of traditional classroom courses and differ substantially from language courses for students, for example individual coaching. The participants of this meeting and the working group members will discuss the organization of such instruction and who the target groups would be in this case.
