Erasmus – General facts

- Students can be funded
 - for up to 360 days during their BA
 - for up to 360 days during their MA
 - for up to 360 days during their PhD
- Study and/or internship
- 27 EU member states and Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway and Turkey



Studying Abroad - Erasmus

- 1-2 semesters at an Erasmus partner university of your specific program of study
- Tuition fee waiver at host university
- Credits will be recognized
- Erasmus mobility grant



Studying Abroad - Erasmus

Pre-requisites for funding:

- Full-time enrollment at the University of Bremen
- Language: at least B2 in language of instruction
- Basic knowledge of the language spoken in the host country is always beneficial

- Application: anytime

PROMOS – General facts

- Everywhere outside of the EU (outside of Erasmus)
- Study: 1 – 4 months
- Internships: 6 weeks – 4 months
- Language course: 3 weeks – 4 months
- Specialized courses (ex: summer course)- up to 6 weeks



Bremer Studienfonds

- for Students and Graduates (up to 3 months after)
- Maximum duration 6 months
- **No funding for:** stays that are compulsory in the study course and final theses
- Project-Application
- Deadlines January, 15th and June, 15th
