All courses at Avignon University are taught in French language (except for specific programs such as Hispanic studies and Languages, Regional and Foreign Literature and Civilization, and some of Foreign Applied Languages courses)

A B2 level of French is required to attend the courses, and a C1 level is recommended for law studies.

If you want to study French, the SDL (Languages Service of the International House) welcomes foreign students who wish to take French language and culture classes.

All classes are taught by highly qualified teachers, under the scientific supervision of researchers specialized in the didactics of French as a Foreign Language. The SDL is a member of ADCUEFE, the national network of French language university centres.

These courses grant you a 'DU', a University Diploma in French Language, according to the CECRL (Common European Language Framework). Levels taught: from beginner level to advanced (A1 to C1)
