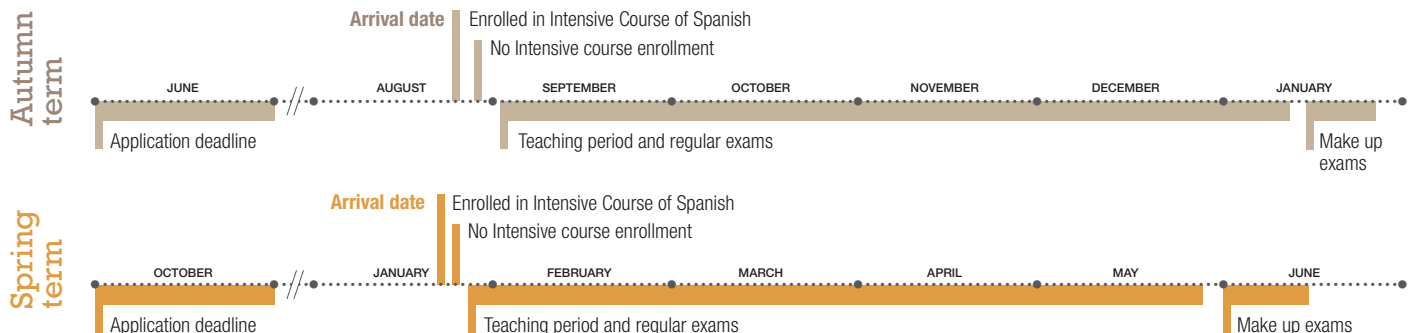
Research
