CORONA INFORMATION - UNIVERSITY OF BREMEN -

Situation at University of Bremen:

- Offices still closed until at least end of October
- All lectures are planned online, face to face only where possible (small groups, big rooms)
- Observing of safety rules (distance 1,5 2 metres, face mask, no entry on campus with symptoms (fever, cough), hand disinfection upon entry into buildings, cough and sneezing etiquette)



CORONA INFORMATION - BREMEN

- Distance 1,5 metres in public, 2 metres in closed rooms
- Face mask (nose and mouth cover) in public transport, shops, museums etc. or if distance of 1,5 m cannot be maintained
- Observe safety rules of buildings you enter (filling of forms on entry with personal details for infection chains, hand disinfection, face mask ..)
- Observe quarantine (if applicable)
- Perform Corona-Test on health authorities' request
- No gatherings of more than 10 Persons in public
- Exceptions only with concept for protection and hygiene

CORONA: QUARANTINE INFO

- If coming from high risk area: 14 days quarantine at home (list of "high risk areas" see website of "Robert Koch Institut")
- Information of health authorities: ordnungsamt@uni-bremen.de
- Exception: valid laboratory certificate stating that you do not have Covid-19, max. 48 hours old (send by email to "Ordnungsamt") upon entering Germany
- Regulations might change until end of September/beginning of October
- Option: Corona-testing immediately after arrival at the "Corona Test Center" (behind main train station)



CORONA: QUARANTINE INFO

Examples of "High Risk Areas" as per 22.09.2020 might have changed already:

- Azerbaijan, Ecudaor, Iran, Kirgistan, Nigeria, Russian Federation, Spain, Tanzania, Turkey,
 United Kingdom
- Parts of Belgium, France, Rumania, Croatia, Hungary
- Please check the website of the "Robert-Koch-Institut" if your country of departure is among the "high risk areas" at the time of your departure: https://www.rki.de/DE/Content/InfAZ/N/Neuartiges_Coronavirus/Risikogebiete_neu.html
- All persons coming from any of these regions have to observe a 14-days Quarantine or have to produce a valid negative Covid-19 laboratory test result upon arrival.



FORMALITIES AT ARRIVAL

City registration ("Anmeldung" beim Meldeamt):

- register at the municipal office in Bremen (or if you live outside of Bremen at the corresponding municipal office) within 2 weeks after taking residence in Bremen
- after successful registration at the municipal office, you will receive a confirmation of your registration ("Meldebestätigung"). You will need this document e.g. to apply for a library card or to open a bank account
- Documents needed: "Wohnungsgeberbescheinigung", "Meldeformular"

FORMALITIES AT ARRIVAL

- Certificate of Arrival (Erasmus: physical presence or online studies from abroad? in Mobility Online, details will follow by email)
- Residence Permit (e.g. for Brazil, Japan, South Korea, Canada, US...)
- Semester Documents
- Valid negative Corona-Test (no older than 48 hours) to submit to "Ordnungsamt" or health authorities on arrival (if applicable)



DOCUMENTS TO BRING TO BREMEN

- valid ID or Passport
- Arrival Certificate form of your home university (if required by home university)
- Study Visa (for non-EU citizens without study permit for another Schengen state)
- Mobility Pass (for non-EU citizens with study permit for another Schengen state and successful BAMF registration)
- passport photos (for semester ticket, ...)
- valid EHIC or other Health Insurance Certificate (AT11 for Turkish citizens, private health insurance for students over 30 years of age,...)

Attention non-EU citizens: if you study online from abroad and come to Bremen later (e.g. in case of visa problems), you still have to pay the statutory health insurance for the whole semester!

Stud.IP, Webmail and course registration



STUD.IP

- Each student of the University of Bremen receives access data for a personal email account (...@uni-bremen.de) from the "Zentrum für Netze" (Zfn; IT services).
- The access data is used for the email account with ZfN as well as for Stud.IP. It is necessary to check both inboxes on a regular basis.
- The access data will be communicated via email as soon as the enrolment at the University of Bremen is completed.
- Stud.IP is the course management system at the University of Bremen. Most lecturers and professors use Stud.IP for their courses.
