Campus Tours

Since last week Bremen is a "risk area" (new infections above 50 per 100.000 on average over the last 7 days)

 Only groups of 5 persons are allowed in public -> Campus tours have to be split into smaller groups

Help us lower the infection rate in Bremen by observing the general safety and hygiene rules!

- minimize contacts to other persons, keep a distance of minimum 1.5m
- wear face masks where minimum distance of 1,5 m cannot be maintained

- do not go out if you feel ill, Call a doctor if you show symptoms of Covid-19





Corona in Bremen

Since last week **Bremen is a "risk area"** (new infections above 50 per 100.000 on average over the last 7 days)

- -> Bremen authorities have released more strict regulations, for example:
- Only groups of 5 persons are allowed in public
- Restaurants will close earlier, restrictions on alcohol sales
- nose and mouth covers will be compulsory in more places (observe the signs!)
- -> Travelling to other regions will be more difficult (quarantine regulations!)

Please note that entry and quarantine regulations will change on the 15th of October!

-> if you are not yet in Bremen, please check the entry regulations before your departure!
