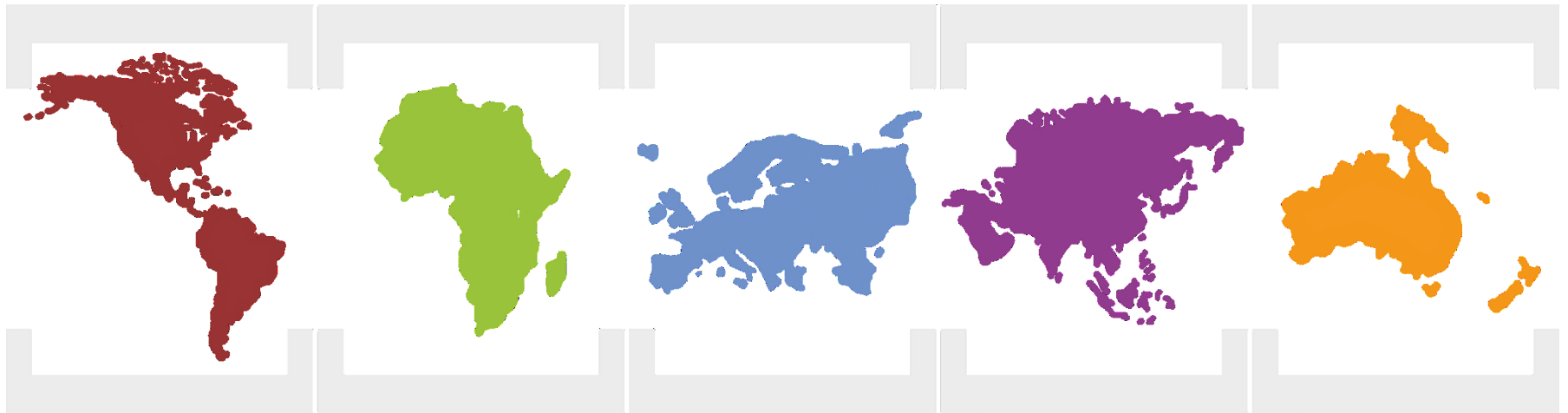

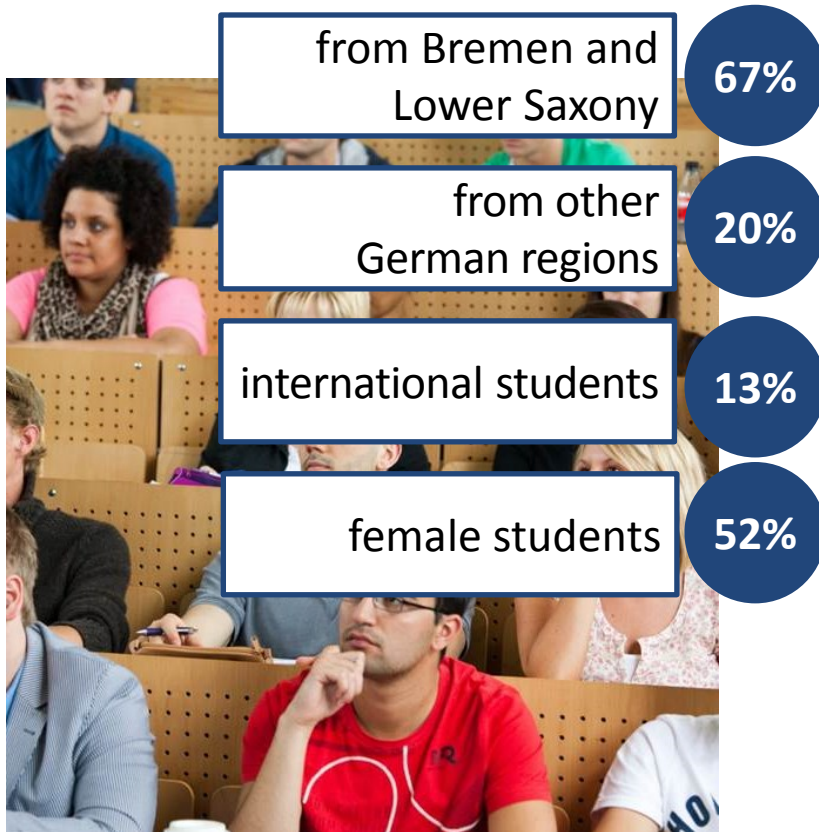

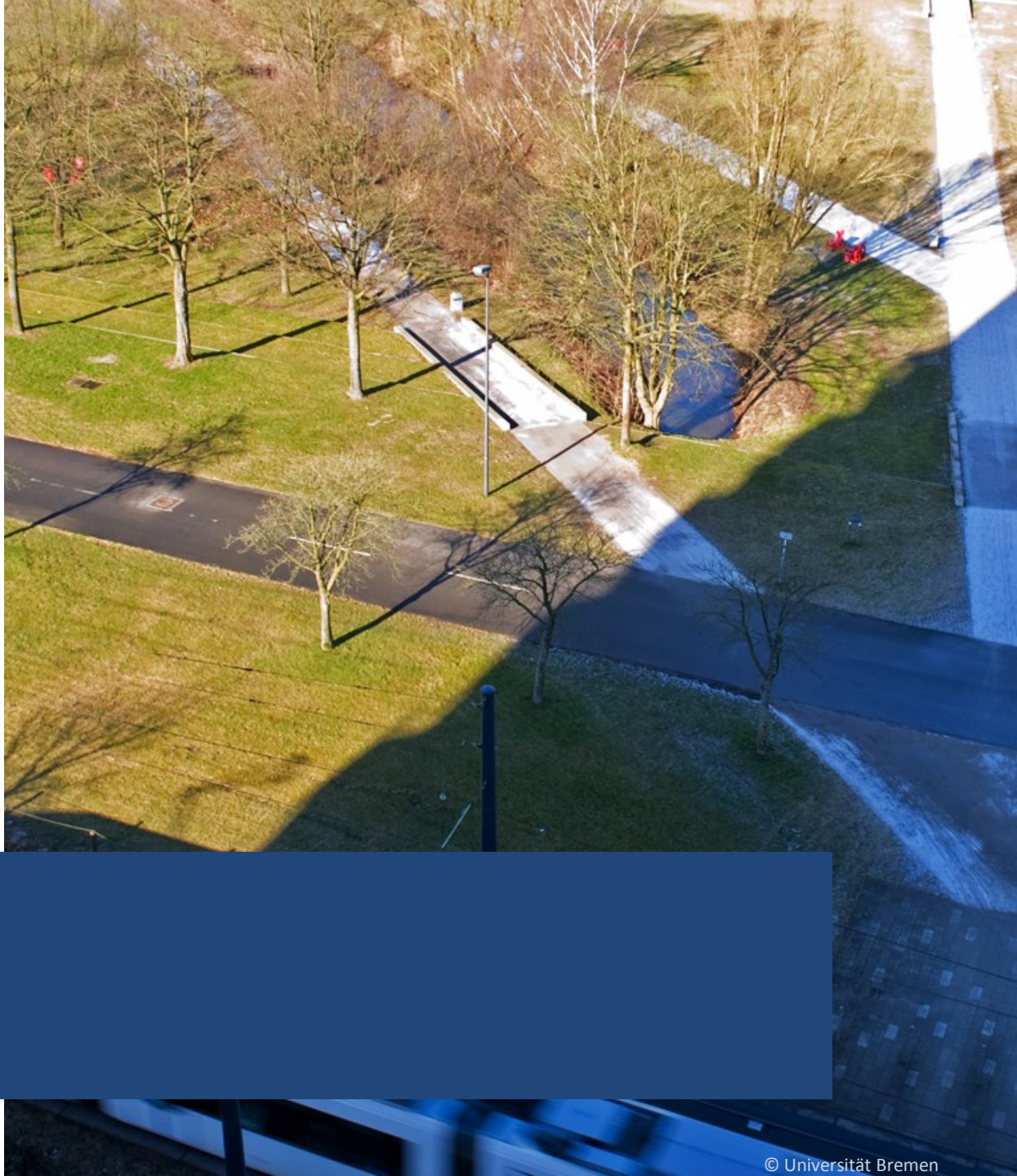

- Quality of weightlessness not achieved in outer space



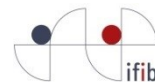

- Restaurants will close earlier, restrictions on alcohol sales
- nose and mouth covers will be compulsory in more places (observe the signs!)

-> Travelling to other regions will be more difficult (quarantine regulations!)

-> if you are not yet in Bremen, please check the entry regulations before your departure!

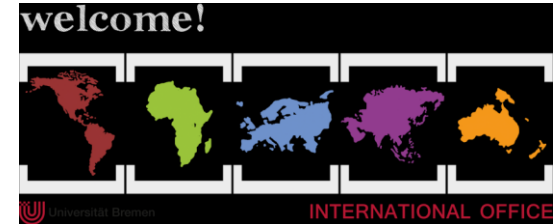
