Funds from the Internationalization Fund of the University of Bremen will only be provided if no other funding possibilities (for example, funds allocated to the departments, funds from other central funds such as YERUN Research Mobility Award, Cardiff Fund) or third-party funds are available for the measures. The following measures and activities can therefore NOT be financed via the I-Fund:

3. separate funding line crisis fund

As a support option for international exchange in acute political and social crisis situations as well as in the context of natural disasters, the Internationalization Fund offers the possibility to apply for travel and accommodation grants for students and scientists from acutely affected regions.

- For travel expenses, up to € 800 within Europe or € 1,500 outside Europe can be applied for once per person/trip
- Residence costs for students and doctoral candidates 54 €/per day up to 22 days, 1200 €/per month
- Residence costs for scientists: 89 €/per day up to 22 days and 2000 €/per month

Applications can be submitted on a continuous basis. The allocation is made after receipt of the applications until the available funds are exhausted.

The selection committee for the crisis fund consists of the Vice-Rector for Internationality, Academic Qualification and Diversity, the head of the International Office and the internationalization officer of the respective participating/receiving department.
