Pursuant to the regulations governing doctoral studies last amended 22 June 2011, the following documents must be submitted in order to be admitted to the doctoral examination (Dr. rer. nat.):

- 1. **Application form: "Application for admission to the doctoral examination"** (can be downloaded at https://www.uni-bremen.de/zpa/promotion/dr-rer-nat-fb-08/)
- 2. Five bound copies of the doctoral dissertation including a declaration in writing to the effect that
 - the doctoral dissertation is the candidate's own work without recourse to any unauthorised aids,
 - he/she used only such sources and aids as are included in the references and
 - he/she made due reference to all the works either quoted or used as the basis for ideas.

This declaration is to be signed by the candidate and included at the end of each bound copy of the doctoral dissertation.

Of the five copies, two are to be presented to the supervisor, two to the examiners and one is kept by the ZPA.

- 3. Detailed curriculum vitae
- 4. List of academic publications, if any

The following documents must be additionally submitted in the event that the candidate is not enrolled as a doctoral student:

- 5. Evidence of having completed an academic degree programme of at least eight semesters, involving studies in a discipline which may be considered relevant for the planned doctoral dissertation (final examination certificate);
- 6. Evidence of having been awarded a first qualifying degree (*Diploma*, State Examination, *Magister*, Bachelor or Master degree in every case to be certified or submitted in original and copy);
- 7. Written declaration as to whether and, if so, with what result the candidate had previously applied for admittance to a doctoral examination;
- 8. Pursuant to Article 5 (1), a declaration of a professor belonging to Faculty 8 agreeing to act as examiner and stating that there is a relationship between the topic of the dissertation and a field of research at the Faculty 08.
- 9. Survey for statistics on doctoral candidates at the University of Bremen www.uni-bremen.de/en/promostatis. You will automatically receive an e-mail with a copy of your answers. Please include this copy with your application.
