# Important information for your start in Bremen

# Arrival in Bremen

## Documents and first steps:

- buy a train ticket for *trains* to get to Bremen (use your semester ticket for trams (= BSAG) and regional trains)
- extend your visa
- register in Bremen
- get a health insurance
- apply for residence permit
- open a bank account

## Bring (recommendations):

- money for the first days before you can open your bank account (food, rent, Covid test etc.)
- roaming package (for Internet and emergency calls in the first days)
- warm, water-resistant clothes

# General Corona Information

**Most protective measures have been lifted**
